***I have a standard eight-week turnaround time for quilting, custom quilts may have a longer wait time. You will receive your quilt eight weeks from the date received or the date you reserved by phone/email. To avoid this long wait time, I recommend calling halfway through your project. This will put you in the quilting queue and the wait time seems significantly shorter. ***

Quilt Prep

Your quilt will be quilted on the condition it is received and will be as free of tucks, pleats and puckers as well as your piecing allows.

BORDERS - If your borders are wavy, a pleat will be taken in the least visible place possible or your borders will be removed/fixed/replaced. There may be an extra charge for this depending upon difficulty. Wavy borders are the result of (1) improperly measured center quilts (the sides, instead of the center), (2) pieced borders, (3) blocks on point with bias edges on setting triangles next to the border instead of next to the block.

BACKING - It is impossible to center your top on the back in both directions. The top shrinks as it is quilted - anywhere from 2%-10% in one direction. I will do my best to center it if you have a directional backing. Please clip any loose threads and press seams in the back.

THREAD - If you check the "blend thread" box, I will use a color thread to blend in with the top. If you have a lot of contrast in the color of your fabrics, I will use a variegated thread to incorporate all the colors, or use the predominant color. If desired, specify color of thread, otherwise leave the choice to me. The same color will be used top and bottom. If you check the "show quilting thread" box, you will be able to see the quilting in a pleasing contrasting color. If a color change is requested in different areas of the quilt, an extra charge may apply as the quilt will need to be "rolled" twice.

TEXTILES - If minkie or chenille is used as an outer border or backing, there may be an extra charge. These materials stretch and their edges curl. Also, T-shirt quilts **MUST** be stabilized on the back with iron-on fusible interfacing. I cannot guarantee that the foot will not drag the knit fabric and quilt in wrinkles. Having said that, I have quilted many T-shirt quilts without problems.

FLANGE or APPLIQUE - An edge-to-edge pattern cannot be used over an accent border with a flange edge. The pattern will be centered over the top and an extra charge for a custom border will apply. Applique will be quilted over, unless specified to "trim & sew" around for an additional cost.
